Policy on Conduct of Remedial Programmes

Realizing that each student has a different learning curve than others, the Federal Institute of Science and Technology ensures that it identifies students facing difficulties in learning, and extra effort is made towards individual development and prolific learning effectiveness. Remedial programmes are designed to close the gap between what students know and what they're expected to know. Slow learners are identified based on the criteria decided by the department. Each faculty initiates special remedial measures to give more attention and support to the slow learners. The faculty handling the course plans different activities to help the students overcome their learning difficulties. Each department shall entrust a faculty as the remedial coordinator. Remedial classes are scheduled via a remedial timetable prepared by the remedial coordinator. Remedial measures may include conducting special teaching sessions for the slow learners, discussing previous question papers, distributing self-learning materials, creating study circles etc. The progress made by these students after the remedial sessions shall be evaluated periodically.

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
