Policy on MoU/Collaborations

The Federal Institute of Science and Technology (FISAT) aims to improve students' employability skills by bridging the gap between academics and industry requirements. Therefore, FISAT encourages the signing of MoUs with Industry to support the availability of Internships, Industrial Visits, Industrial Projects, etc to the students.

a. The institution/departments identify suitable industries/institutions for entering into an MoU/collaboration based on the expertise of the industry/institution and their willingness to engage with FISAT.

The MoU may strive for the following:

- To foster collaboration, provide the opportunity for global experience, and facilitate the advancement of knowledge based on reciprocity, best effort, mutual benefit, and frequent interactions.
- To exchange information on research and educational programmes.
- To exchange information on teaching, learning material, and other literature relevant to their academic and research programmes.
- To jointly organize short-term continuing education programmes on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- To jointly organize seminars, conferences, or workshops on matters of mutual interest and to ask each other's faculty to participate therein
- Together propose and engage in research or training programmes sponsored by funding agencies and invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- On a reciprocal basis, to exchange students at Undergraduate, Graduate, and Doctoral levels for limited periods for education and research.

b. Detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity of the MoU are separately determined and agreed upon by the two institutions. These terms include a technical description of the proposed action, financial arrangements, person(s) responsible for its implementation, etc.

c. Arbitration Clause is included to take care of any disputes that may arise.

d. The MoU/Collaboration agreements must be legally vetted by the legal authority specified by the institution.

e. All MoU/Collaborations agreements should be placed before the Management for approval. After approval, Chairman/Principal are the only authorized persons to represent the institution and sign the MoUs/Collaboration agreements.
